MULTI-STAGE PREP & PAINT PROCESS

Homecrest takes the necessary steps to properly prepare material for paint application. The multiple, pre-paint steps listed below are important for the proper adhesion of all powder-coat frame finishes.






STAGE 1: PRE-WASHRemoves large contaminants.



STAGE 2: DETERGENT WASH




STAGE 3: PRE-RINSERinses off carry-over detergents.



STAGE 4: RINSEFinal rinse prior to chemical application.



STAGE 5: CHEMICAL ETCHSeals and creates paintable surface.



STAGE 6: RINSE
Rinse off carry-over chemical.



STAGE 7: PAINT APPLICATIONElectrostatic equipment is used to consistently coat all areas of the frame.



STAGE 8: PAINT CUREPowder-coat cures at an oven temp of 420 degrees for 22 minutes.
